

Class 4 Newsletter Spring Term - 16/03/2018



This Week

Our Theme for this half term is the 'A Greek Odyssey'. In English, we have begun to explore the genre of historical fiction. We are using the source text of Homer's Odyssey and his account of the Trojan Horse. We are dissecting it this week so we have a good understanding of how history and fiction intertwine. In Maths, our focus is still to do with shape, space and measure, but it has shifted from calculating the area (space inside) a shape to the perimeter (space around the edge). We also had a fantastic Maths morning on Wednesday. We explored pentominoes with Mrs Bolton, worked out how much it would cost to buy some tablecloths with me and went on a Maths treasure hunt with Miss Morris. We all had a lot of fun. In Science, we continued to follow the development of Mrs Smith's pregnancy and added new measurements to our graphs. We also focussed on accurate measuring of our height and middle finger to explore if there was a connection between the two. We then created a scatter graph depicting our results. In **RE**, the Year 5 children have continued in their Bible Exploration with James B. The Year 4's began to explore Judas' role in the Easter story and why he would want to betray Jesus. Some of our responses were very thoughtful and creative. In History, we explored how two Ancient Greek cities were governed. We also participated in a debate in the style of an Athenian democracy (the foundations for modern British democracy). In PE, we applied all our gymnastics skills in our final week of our programme. The Year 5s applied their passing and moving skills and the Year 4 children went swimming. In Computing, we continued coding our games full of variables.
