This week in Class 2, we have been learning about Pentecost and created our own Pentecost art. In our English work we have been writing about our fantastic visit to the farm last week, using past tense and noun phrases in our recounts.



We have explored how 'w' and 'qu' change the sound of letters in our spelling and looked at the homophones wear/where. In Maths we have completed our unit on fractions and begun learning about time.

Our Science work has focussed on animal life cycles and the human life cycle. We have used maps and alpha-numeric grids in our Geography work and planned our models for making next week during our Showcase afternoon.

Next week, we are really looking forward to our Class 2 Showcase on Wednesday afternoon when we will be making our wheeled models; hopefully with your help and support.
