This Week

Our Theme for this term is 'Water, Water Everywhere!'

We 'Moved-on' on Monday morning to our next year group; the Year 5's with Miss Morris and the Year 4's with me. In English, we have explored the grammatical features of a newspaper, editing and improving previous articles based on the Nepal earthquake in 2015. In Maths, our focus has been on measurement; we have converted time and explored how to measure the volume of certain shapes. In RE, we looked at the friendship between Jonathan and David further, amidst the persecution of King Saul. We then looked on the Open Doors website to see how some Christians today are being persecuted in a similar way to David. We wrote prayers in response. In PE, we continued to improve our hand-eye coordination through the sport of rounders. In Geography and Science, we explored a river in more depth, identifying the different courses and features of a river. We then revisited our models we created last week of the water cycle.
