We are Scientists!



This week in **Mathematics** we have been focusing on number bonds for ten and twenty, addition and subtraction vocabulary and basic skills.

Our **English** work this week has continued to be linked to the story 'The Princess and the Giant' by Caryl Hart. The children have also been exploring the use of conjunctions – 'and', 'but' and 'or' to combine sentences. Our spelling work has focused on ur/ir patterns. In **Science** we have been investigating places where germs grow. We are looking forward to seeing the results of our investigation next week.

Our **Geography** work this week has focused on identifying the continents of the world and using atlases to research and answer questions about the continents.

In Computing we have been using graphics packages to create colourful art.
