

# When are the 2017 KS2 SATs?

**The 2017 KS2 SATs tests are planned to take place across the week commencing 8th May as set out in the following draft exam timetable:**

<u>Date</u>	<u>SATs Paper</u>
Monday 8th May 2017	English Reading
Tuesday 9th May 2017	Spelling, Punctuation & Grammar - Paper 1 (Short Answer Questions) Spelling, Punctuation & Grammar - Paper 2 (Spelling)
Wednesday 10th May 2017	Maths - Paper 1 (Arithmetic) Maths - Paper 2 (Reasoning)
Thursday 11th May 2017	Maths - Paper 3 (Reasoning)

## **What is a KS2 SATs Scaled Score?**

One of the most significant changes that first came with the 2016 KS2 SATs Papers was the removal of "levels". Levels, (such as **2a**, **3b** or **4c**) used to give some reflection of how a particular child is performing against the expectations of the national curriculum. Instead of levels, children are now given an easy to understand **scaled score** with 100 representing the "national standard".

The interpretation of scaled scores is as follows:

<b>Mark</b>	<b>Description</b>
< 100	Below Expected Standard
= 100	At Expected Standard
> 100	Above Expected Standard
