## When are the 2017 KS2 SATs?

## The *2017 KS2 SATs* tests are planned to take place across the week commencing 8th May as set out in the following draft exam timetable:

## What is a KS2 SATs Scaled Score?

One of the most significant changes that first came with the 2016 KS2 SATs Papers was the removal of "levels". Levels, (such as **2a**, **3b** or **4c**) used to give some reflection of how a particular child is performing against the expectations of the national curriculum. Instead of levels, children are now given an easy to understand **scaled score** with 100 representing the "national standard".

The interpretation of scaled scores is as follows:

| Mark  | Description             |
|-------|-------------------------|
| < 100 | Below Expected Standard |
| = 100 | At Expected Standard    |
| > 100 | Above Expected Standard |
