


Our **English** work will continue focusing on the Secret Garden. We will be finding evidence in the text to support ideas and use past and present tense in our writing.

In our **Science** work we will be investigating how peas or beans grow and change over time and planting seeds and bulbs we have been growing in class in our school garden.
