#### **CHRISTMAS ONLINE SAFETY**

#### **Extra Funding**

All schools receive extra funding for pupils who are registered for the Pupil Premium Grant. Pupils are eligible if their parents are in receipt of Income Support, Jobseekers Allowance, Child Tax Credit with an annual income of less than £16190 and **not** receiving Working Tax Credit. **Even if your child is in KS1 and receiving Universal Free School Meals**, please ring to see if you are eligible; the extra funding makes all the difference. If you meet this criteria, please phone the Lancashire County Council Pupil Access Team on 01772 531809 and register for the grant. They will be able to confirm quickly and easily over the phone whether or not you are eligible. Our children really benefit from this extra funding so we really urge you to register and it will only take a few minutes of your time. Thank you.
