## We are Biologists!

In our **English** work we have continued reading the classic story "The Secret Garden" by Frances Hodgson Burnett. We have explored how the behaviour of the main character has changed – finding evidence in the text and focused on writing extended sentences.

In **Mathematics** we have been adding and subtracting two-digit numbers using number lines and other strategies. We have begun exploring measures – temperature and length, through our science activities.

Our **Science** work has focused on investigating plants, trees and leaves. We have observed and identified trees, taken measurements and collected leaf samples to measure and record.

In Geography we have been finding out more about the UK and focused on our own country, England.

Our **English** work will continue focusing on the Secret Garden. We will be finding evidence in the text to support ideas and continue to develop our use of past and present tense in our writing, writing letters and diary entries.

In **Mathematics** we will be focus on measurement using volume and capacity and temperature. We will also continue practising our addition and subtraction of two digit numbers using a range of strategies.

In **RE** we will continue looking at stories from the Old Testament.

Our **Science** work we will be investigating trees further and leaf patterns.

In Geography we will be using maps to answer questions and simple maps to compare two different locations.
