This Week

In **English**, we have spent the week planning and writing our own newspaper reports about the Great Fire of London. We have sought to apply all the grammar features necessary and show off our ability to go above and beyond. In **Maths**, we have continued with written methods, this time for division. We have consolidated our understanding of the short written method and applied it in real world situations. Our knowledge of division will set us up for our learning about fractions for the next few weeks. In **Science**; we investigated the friction that shoes create. Not only did we conduct the investigation I thought of, but we had a warm up experiment thanks to the inquisitive mind of Alex. In **RE**, we continued to create an interactive retelling of the nativity using computers. In **DT/Topic**, we explored the nets of 3D shapes and began to plan our own versions of St Paul's Cathedral. In **PE**, we continued to focus on our balance, this time while dismounting from apparatus (with the added difficulty of keeping a quoit on our head!). We were seeking to control our balance following a pike jump. The Year 5 children also went swimming.
