### We are Explorers!

Our **RE** work this week has focused on English traditions and celebrations of Easter.

In our **English** work we have heard about Pintsize, the naughty pig, and his antics at Mudpuddle Farm. We have been generating adverbs, writing noun phrases and using commas in lists. We have also begun looking at apostrophes for possession.

In **Mathematics** we have been practising our addition skills – adding 3 single-digit numbers, two-digit numbers and single digits and two two-digit numbers. We have also practised our subtraction facts.

Our **Science** work has focused on investigating what happens to different materials when we freeze them. The children enjoyed predicting and then testing their ideas with some surprising results!

In **Geography** we have begun looking at aerial/plan views and made our own simple sketch maps.
