This Week

This week in **English**, we started by writing our own versions of a chapter from the Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe and consequently improved it using similes. The results have been superb. In **Maths**, we moved on from addition and subtraction to shape, space and measure. We have identified all types of angles, measured them using protractors, and investigated the locations of perpendicular and parallel lines around school. In **PE**, we improved our dribbling, passing and other elements of ball control in hockey. In **Science**, we researched the history of electricity and how it is developed over time. In **RE**, we continued our discussion on the persecuted church and how Christians worship God in difficult circumstances. In **Computing**, due to changes in timetable last week, we actually finished our **e-safety** PowerPoints. We also investigated the security of our passwords. We continued with regular practise for Sing Together.
