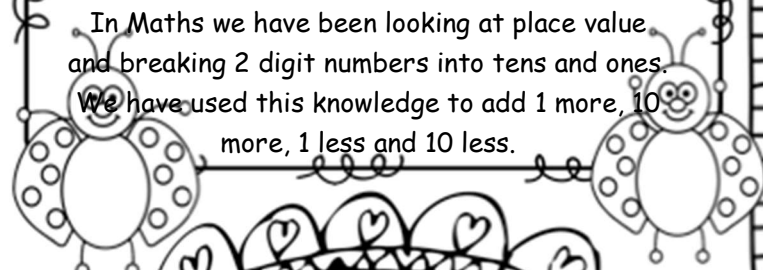


This Week...

In English we have been looking at traditional rhymes such as 'Pat-a-cake, Pat-a-cake', 'Three Blind Mice' and 'Jack and Jill'.

The children have been finding rhyming words and noticed that the last two sounds in rhyming words often match! We have linked our phonics this week with our rhyming words, noticing that sometimes the same sound is spelt differently e.g. pail and whale. At the end of the week the children wrote their own rhyme by adapting 'Mary, Mary quite contrary' we will be displaying these poems in school.

In Maths we have been looking at place value, and breaking 2 digit numbers into tens and ones. We have used this knowledge to add 1 more, 10 more, 1 less and 10 less.

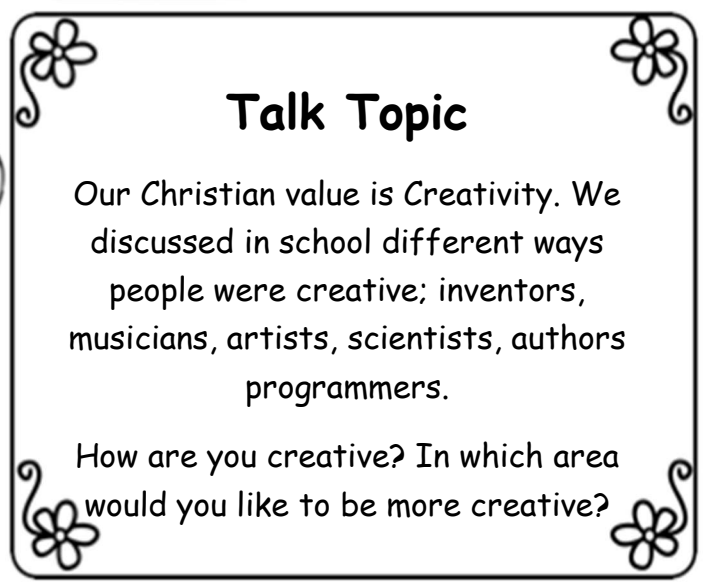
