## This Week - We are Hatching Chicks!



This week has been a wonderfully exciting and fascinating one for Class 2. We welcomed the arrival of ten chicken eggs and an incubator on Monday morning and on Thursday experienced the hatching process.



In our **English** lessons we have continued looking at information books and developing our comprehension skills. We have also recorded our experiences of the chicks hatching out.

In Mathematics we have been looking at fractions, matching equivalent fractions and found fractions of numbers.

In **Science** lessons this week we have begun exploring plants and growth. We have planted beans and peas and identified different plants both inside and outdoors.

We have explored plants as food in our **DT** lessons and sampled different fruit salad products, discussing our preferences and what appeals to us as consumers.

In our Art work we have produced observational drawings/paintings of flowering plants.
