This Week

This week in **English**, our focus has been on the punctuation needed for instruction and explanation writing. We learned how to use semi-colons, colons and brackets accurately. Our **Maths** focus was on prime numbers and factors; applying our knowledge of them through challenges. In **RE**, we created pieces of artwork based on what the Bible says about itself. In **PE**, we started our unit of dance linking in with **Music**. We used the 'BBC 10 Pieces' as inspiration, in particular the Anna Meredith piece called 'Connect It' that uses the body to create music. We continued with regular practise for **Sing Together**, we are becoming more confident with the words and melody and are having more of a focus on breathing techniques to best project while singing.
