Hello and welcome to the first Class Three newsletter of the school year. It has been a lovely first week with the new class and all of the children have settled into life in Class Three without missing a step. Throughout the week the new members of the class have been acclimatising to the routines, responsibilities and expectations that we have in Class Three. The children have also spent their first week being introduced to the topics for the term, how to use the support materials that they have in their trays, and accommodating themselves with the way that they present their work and respond to the marking and comments in their books.

In Maths next week the class will be converting numbers into words and partitioning numbers in order to be able to add/subtract larger numbers. Next week in English the children will be identifying and using a variety of sentence starters, connectives and adjectives to make their writing even more exciting. The Science topic for this term is Light and Shadows and next week the children will carry out their first investigation of shadows. The topic in R.E. is Harvest and next week the class will begin to explore the celebration of Harvest. The P.E. topic is Invasion Games and this will continue with some Basketball and Hockey skills next week.
