In **Mathematics** we have been working on addition of 3 single digit numbers, adding tens, and addition/subtraction of TUs. We have explored different methods including number lines, pictorial representations and more formal written methods.

In our **English** work we have practised our punctuation and sentence structures. We have been writing our own poems using simple structures and practised performing these for an audience. We will also be learning and performing simple poems and songs for our Easter celebrations.

In **Science** we have been exploring the importance of humans to take exercise and eat the right kinds of foods. We have looked at food groups and the Eatwell Plate. This will link with our **DT** lessons where we will be making our own fruit kebabs. This week we have planned our kebabs and listed ingredients we will need to make them.

In Art we have created our own pictures in the Impressionist style using paint and fingers.



In our **RE** lessons we have explored the Bible and the Easter story and recorded the main events of Easter in our work.
