This Week

Our Theme for this half term is 'A Greek Odyssey'. In English, we wrote our own versions of the Trojan Horse historical story. Our focus was using complex sentences beginning with fronted adverbials as well as beginning with 'ing' and 'ed verbs. We have really enjoyed writing this half term, using our theme as a basis for our inspiration. In Maths, our focus has been on coordinates. We added new learning each day, and we can now locate, plot and translate coordinates. Some of us even ventured outside to help us visualise translating coordinates. In Science, we continued to follow the development of Mrs Smith's pregnancy and added new measurements to our graphs. We also researched the processes and characteristics that all living things have in common. We used the acronym MRS GREN to help us remember them. In RE, we wrote a newspaper recount of the Easter story, applying what we know of that style of writing; the Year 5 children have continued in their Bible Exploration with James B. The Year 4's expressed the betrayal of Judas through art. In History, we explored how architecture and art can help. In PE, we investigated the most effective way to pass a ball using a variety of drills. The Year 5's applied their passing and moving skills and the Year 4 children went swimming. We also began to present our projects to the class (something that will continue next week).
