We have written alien stories based on the plot of Fiona Robertson's book. The children have amazed me with their creativity and story writing skills.

In Maths we have talked about how a fraction is an equal part of a whole. We have been finding halves and quarters of shapes and amounts.

Phonics:

Mrs Williamson's group have looked at how to spell the phase 4 tricky words. And have looked at 'wh' saying 'w' and 'h' e.g. **whole** and **when**.

They have also learnt 'ph' e.g. **elephant**.
