### Key Stage 2 SATs 2017

On the 8<sup>th</sup> of May SATs week begins. In that week your child will sit a Reading Test, Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar Test, an Arithmetic Test and two Maths Reasoning Tests. These tests will be split over four days and will take place in the mornings when children are at their best.

Over the last few weeks we have spent a great deal of time preparing for these tests. From Booster Classes, past papers and Maths and English intervention we have attempted to give your child all the tools they need to do their very best. The Standards and Testing Agency require all schools to conduct the tests in the same way and we will be strictly adhering to these rules. Most children will sit the test either in the hall or in the Year 6 Classroom. With the exception of the reading test, all children can ask for questions to be read to them. We cannot however, give children any help with their answers.

It is essential that your child arrives at SATs week ready to do well. Whilst your child may be nervous please try to ensure that before each test they get a good night's sleep, they have had a good breakfast in the morning and that they arrive at school on time. I will also be providing a breakfast in class to make sure children are ready and relaxed. If you have any questions or concerns about SATs please do not hesitate to contact us.
