

Parent's Meeting – Class 3 – 7th September 2017 @ 6pm

- **Welcome and introductions** – Mrs Bolton will teach all the core subjects and History/Geography, Mrs Morris teaches some of the Foundation subjects such as Art, PE and Music. We also have Mrs Catterall who works in class delivering some interventions.
- **Year 3 – KS2** – There is a move towards independence and responsibility. The children are taught a variety of strategies to foster independence; use of dictionaries, ask a friend, reading through question again, look back in notes, using Working Walls etc
- **Curriculum – Yr 3 and 4 KLIPs for Reading, Writing and Maths.** These are the expectations for the end of year. All children work at different rates and have different abilities and skills. We assess children individually and tailor the curriculum accordingly.
- **Changes in our curriculum regarding Spellings and Handwriting** – Word lists for parents. These are the words that your children are required to read and spell by the end of the year. We use a variety of strategies to teach these words and expect the children to apply them in their writing. The handwriting handout shows the letter formation that we teach the children with the lead in and lead out stroke.
- **Non-Negotiables – Rules and how we keep them.**

Our rules are

 - a) Treat others the way you wish to be treated.
 - b) Look after school property.
 - c) Work sensibly and quietly.
 - d) Listen to, and look at, the person who is speaking.
 - e) Always do our best work

We use the cloud system, team points and table points. Children may be kept in class at playtime and lunchtime as a consequence for poor behaviour.
- **Homework** – Reading – please complete Reading records to show that your child has read and ask any questions that you are not sure about, Multiplication tables – please practise these as regularly as possible because they have a huge impact on much of the Maths work we do. A piece of English, Maths or Science is sent home each week on a Friday to be handed in the following Tuesday.
- **Water bottles** – water is very important to aid your child's concentration. Please send water in a named bottle.
- **PE Kits and all uniform named** – Tuesday and Thursday – must be kept in school at all times, all labelled please.
