Next week we are going to be looking at my favourite children's book, "the Naughty Bus." The children are going to be doing lots of drama based activities based around this story. We are going to take our learning outside and will be thinking about how to stay safe on the roads. We have done lots of learning around this already but with the summer holidays coming it is even more important that the children are extra vigilant and safe when outside.

We are going to start the transition from Reception to Year 1 and will be doing some activities that will get the children ready for their new classroom. We will also be doing some art work for the children to take home to remind them of their first year at Primary School.

This Week in Reception

We have had a lovely week in Reception this week making our life sized robots. The children all had an input making the robots and we loved being creative using paint, stickers and feathers to create them. The children enjoyed writing letters to their parents inviting them in to see the robots. Many of the children were very knowledgeable about what you need to include in a letter so it was clear that this had been talked about at home. It is great to see the children in class becoming confident writers and they have certainly now got the skills for a good transition into year 1.

In our maths lessons the children have been revising 2d and 3d shapes. We have been thinking about the properties of these shapes and have been using the language of edges and corners. We have also been looking at number patterns, beginning to count in 2, 5, and 10s.

We have been lucky enough to have some South African visitors in school and the children have loved learning all about life in South Africa. The children had lots of misconceptions about the country so we have been busy fact finding. The children loved looking for South Africa on the map of the world.
