This Week

Despite being a wet and windy week weather wise, the school enjoyed a fantastic fund raising event on Wednesday morning. After gathering sponsors and coming into school with wacky hair and wellies, the children walked as many laps of the school playground as they could in order to raise as much money as possible. The children were not put off by the weather and thoroughly enjoyed their morning of fundraising for the school.

In Maths this week the children affected the direction of their learning. After showing an interest in horizontal, vertical, perpendicular, parallel and oblique lines, the children worked on their problem solving skills and the steps that need to be taken when solving a word problem. Next week, as part of Maths week, the class will continue to learn and apply problem solving skills as well as creating their own problems for other children to solve.

In English this week the class developed an introduction for their information texts, as well as converting research notes into sentences of information. This led to the class producing an information text using Microsoft Word that also included images related to their topic. Next week in English the class will finalise their information texts and then integrate their English skills with Maths week. This will include writing word problems for money, measures, geometry, addition, subtraction and multiplication.
