# This Week

In **English**, we have started to write our own story based on 'A Matter of Loaf and Death'. We are seeking to apply the grammar we are practising in **Morning Work** to our writing. In **Maths**, we have applied our division knowledge to fractions. We have also learned how to identify equivalent fractions and add or subtract fractions. In **Science**, we discussed various ways that we can harm our teeth through what we do. We have identified the five major teeth types in the human mouth. We have also carried out a control investigation on how the things we put in our mouth impacts our teeth (but rather than teeth, we have used an egg). *Ask your children about the Hip Hop Hypothesis and what his job is.* In **RE**, we explored the life of Jesus and looked how certain events demonstrated his authority. We dramatized two events where Jesus' authority was clear for others to see. In **PE**, we have added jumps into our routines as well as imitating animal movements that complement using balances.
