This week in **Mathematics** we have been focusing on ten more and ten less, partitioning numbers in different ways and standard measures for length and mass.

Our **English** work this week has linked to the story 'Troll Stroll' by Ellli Woollard. The children have been exploring story themes, identifying adjectives in the text and writing sentences. Our spelling work has focused on _dge/g sounds.

In **Science** we have been investigating fruits and the discovering average number of segments we might find in an orange. Our **Geography** work this week has focused on the countries of the UK and their capitals.

In Computing and Art we have been accessed graphics software to create our own tree pictures using a limited palette.

Please send in a named water bottle for your child to access water as they need it.


