They are already proving to be highly valued members of our team.

Welcome Meetings

All the class teachers are holding or have already held a welcome/meet the teacher, informal session to share expectations and general class information. Information will be put on the website for those who could not attend.

Back to School Reminders

In the morning there is **no adult** on the playground to supervise the children until **08:45**. Children arriving before this time are parents' responsibility.

All children need to have their **full PE kit in school every day.** (White t-shirt, black/blue shorts, black pumps, ankle socks) All items of clothing and footwear especially sweat-shirts, polo shirts and PE kits **must be named**.

If using the Drop Off Zone in the morning on Lea road, or parking directly outside school, please **do NOT park** on the yellow lines. Dinner Money must be sent in on a Friday morning. (£2.20 per day, £11.00 per week).

Toast is available to all children every day; **5p** a day for half a slice in YR, Y1 and Y2 children (25p a week) and 10p a day for KS2 children (50p a week). Toast money must be sent in on a Monday morning for the whole week.

All money should be sent into the office in a clearly marked envelope with the child's name, amount enclosed, and the purpose of the money. There is a red box in the entrance porch, which can be used to safely deliver any money being sent into school.
