This week in our **English** work we have been recalling and performing the story "The Pirates Next Door". We have been writing speech bubbles and explored past tense.

In Mathematics we have been looking at measurement and focused on reading scales, masses and lengths.

In our **RE** lessons we have explored the story "Jesus and the Children" and discussed how Jesus, the disciples and the children interact and relate to each other in the story.

Our **Science** work has focused on light sources and seasons of the year. We have also begun exploring materials and their uses relating to climate and weather
