The roofer is booked for mid may, weather permitting.

It has only been three weeks and your generosity has meant that we have reached a total of £2,700 to date so please keep helping us to reach the final target where you can.

To pay for the work to be carried out we are using-

- The remaining money raised in the roof appeal in 2019 / 20.
- The £3,000 raised in recent weeks.
- Money that had been put in a savings account from historic fundraising bids to repair the roof.

As Church Wardens we are honoured to be part of such a generous community of people who clearly care about St Christophers and who have shown that the future of the building and what it means in Lea is as important as its past.
