We are Fire Fighters!



This week in Mathematics we have continued comparing numbers and looked at rounding numbers to the nearest ten using a number line. We have ordered sets of numbers and been recalling number facts and number bonds for 10 and 20. Your child's homework this week relates to this.

Our English work has linked to the story "George's Dragon at the Fire Station" by Claire Freedman. We have made puppets to retell the story and written character descriptions using adjectives. The children really enjoyed this and being "Picture Detectives" identifying features and thinking of words that could be used to describe the main characters.

For "Talk Time" homework this weekend please encourage your child to share a story book and talk about the main character. What does the character look like? How do we know? What clues are there in the story to help us and what describing words have been used?

In **Topic** work we have begun researching the Great Fire of London on the 350th Anniversary of the event. The children have been accessing the new Museum of London website and discovering lots of facts and information.

In Music we have begun listening to pieces of music with a fire theme. This week we have appraised the work of George Frideric Handel – Music for Royal Fireworks.
