This Week

Our **Theme** for this half term is the "Invaders and Settlers". This week, we have completed our final Summer Assessments. Everyone has given it their all and I am really proud of their attitude coming back from the half term break and hitting the ground running. In **English**, we have re-edited our character descriptions of the Dan Worsley character Bazza. In **Maths**, we have looked at times tables, exploring the commutative nature of them. In **Science**, we have investigated how light reflects off mirrors then have applied it in designing our own periscopes. In **RE**, we have begun our new unit thinking about prayer and how Jesus' prayer life shows us its importance. In **Geography**, we have compared the European cities of Luleå and Kingston-upon-Hull. We are exploring the similarities as export ports. In **PE**, we had a session provided by PNE communities focussing on throwing and passing skills. In **French**, we recapped all our learning thus far in the academic year. In **Art**, we focussed on cutting accurately, inspired by the artist Charles Burrell; this is the first step in a project to create a lighted puppet show. In **Music** we began a new unit, appraising the Bon Jovi track 'Livin' on a Prayer'.
