## We are Reading Ninjas!



This week in Mathematics we have been focusing on counting in $2 \mathrm{~s}, 5 \mathrm{~s}$ and 10 s , finding numbers on a number line, comparing set of numbers and finding one more and one less.

Our English work this week has linked to the story 'The Three Ninja Pigs' by David Bedford and Becka Moor. The children have been exploring story themes, identifying verbs in the text and exploring and writing compound sentences using 'and' and 'but'.


In Science we have been exploring the basic needs for survival. We have begun investigating the amounts of sugar in breakfast cereals and what makes a healthier breakfast.

Our Geography work this week has focused on the World map and the places/countries where some of our foods are grown or produced before they arrive in our shops and supermarkets.
