Mrs Seagrave's Good Manners Award

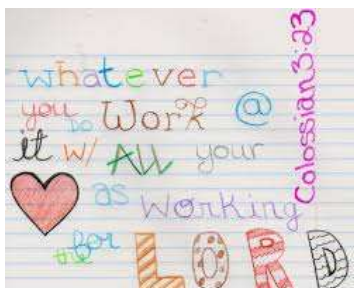
