## This Week

Our Theme for this half term is the 'This Little Light of Mine'. Our focus in Science this week was to carry out an exploration on how mirrors reflect light. We then created a wish-list for investigations and experiments we could carry out. In English, we have continued using the novel 'The Midnight Fox' as the context for our work; we have focussed on making our writing flow across paragraphs, starting our sentences saying when and where the story happens, and re-writing a chapter of the story. In Maths, we focussed on shape; identifying regular and irregular polygons; how we can use known facts about quadrilaterals to identify missing angles and lengths; and identifying 3D shapes from 2D net representations. In RE, we explored how what happens in church services (even how church buildings) have been influenced by the Bible. We thought about service components, prayers and songs. In History, we applied enquiry skills as we looked at artefacts found at the Saxon burial ground in Sutton Hoo. In Computing, we analysed the data collected from our Social Media experiment involving Facebook. In French, we learned how to read, say and recognise body parts. In Music, we have continued reading music and applied it to the song

'Dancing in the Street'.

The CHRISTIAN VALUE award for COURAGE goes to Logan Ormerwood for gaining in courage and contributing to class discussions more.


The **CURRICULUM** award goes to **Emily Hoyle** for super enquiry skills in History using 'Claim, Support, Question'.
