



## This Week

This week in **English**, we have focussed exclusively on embedded relative clauses using relative pronouns. We finished the week by adding relative clauses into a chapter summary of 'The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe.' In **Maths**, we applied our knowledge of angles to help us classify 2D shapes, which we did using Venn and Carroll diagrams. We also have investigated symmetry within 2D shapes and reflecting 2D shapes across lines of symmetry. In **Science**, we produced a timeline of significant dates and events in the electricity timeline. In **RE**, had a fantastic discussion about the Bible; what it is, why Christians read it as well as creating our own questions that we want to answer about the Bible. In **PE**, we improved our dribbling, passing and other elements of ball control in hockey. In **Computing**, we investigated the security of our passwords and started to produce posters advising people how to keep their passwords safe and make them more secure. We continued with regular practise for Sing Together.
