We are Explorers!



We had a wonderful day out at Brockholes Nature Reserve on Wednesday this week. The children explored different habitats - lakes and reeds, woodlands and meadows, and enjoyed hunting for mini-beasts, identifying birds and locating Ratty, Mole, Badger and Toad.

They were also extremely creative exploring the materials in nature and creating mud paintings, environmental art pictures and sculptures!

We were blessed with the perfect weather for the day and the children enjoyed a fantastic learning experience supported by very knowledgeable Rangers on site. Our **Science**, **Topic** and **Art** work have been enhanced by this.



In **Mathematics** this week we have been exploring different methods for solving addition of two 2-digit numbers and begun looking at related subtraction methods.

Our **English** work has focused on characters from the story and collecting evidence from the story to describe the different characters.

Our **RE** work this week has looked at Jesus as a leader and Christians past and present.
