

DINOSAURS Y6 homework project.

We are learning all about animals in school and part of the topic is to know about animals that many scientists believe roamed our Earth millions of years ago! You can use websites and library books to help you! It should ALL be your own work!

The project should be handed in on – Monday 23rd October

There will be 1st, 2nd and 3rd place prizes as well as some projects being marked highly commended.

Projects will be judged on effort, presentation, content and consistency.

Week One

Design a front cover on A4 paper that shows the theme of 'Dinosaurs'. Remember to include your name, some pictures/diagrams and words relating to the topic.

Week Two

Use information books and/or the internet to find out about Mary Anning. Who was she and why is she famous? Create a timeline of her life.

Week Three

Choose an animal that lives on earth today and a type of dinosaur. Compare them by writing how they are different and how they are similar.

Week Four

Write a descriptive poem about a type of dinosaur or dinosaurs in general. Remember to include poetic devices (e.g. descriptive words, powerful verbs, alliteration, repetition, addressing the reader, similes, metaphors etc...) REMEMBER YOUR POEM DOESN'T HAVE TO RHYME. Practice reading it aloud at home ready to perform to the class.

OPTIONAL - If you wish to make a model/bring something in we will display in school.
