Continue with phase 2/3 phonics

More able children - looking at sentence structure (*Writing - Attempts to write short sentences in meaningful contexts.* 40-60 months).

Labelling - (*Writing - starts to make labels and captions* 40-60 months).

Researching about famous astronauts (*UTW - Tech - knows that information can be retrieved from the internet* 40-60 months)

Writing simple facts about space

Making fact books about space

## Maths

Beginning to look at number bonds to 10 •

•*Finds the total number of items in two groups by counting all of them.* 40-60 months

Simple addition and subtraction (*In practical activities and discussion, beginning to use the vocabulary involved in adding and subtracting.* 40-60 months)

Time - using everyday language related to time

Weight and capacity

(*Orders two or three items by length or height. •Orders two items by weight or capacity.* 40-60 months)

Less able - focus group

Continue looking at number 0-10

Making weather charts and tables.

*Friends • British value - having mutual respect for each other*

*Understands that own actions affect other people, for example, becomes upset or tries to comfort another child when they realise they have upset them*

Looking at difference and change - (*Comments and asks questions about aspects of their familiar world such as the place where they live or the natural world. •Can talk about some of the things they have observed such as plants, animals, natural and found objects*) 40 - 60 months

Lights and astronomy

Change in the weather and seasons (linked to maths targets)

## History

Looking at toys in the past and comparing them

Timeline of astronauts going to space

## Exp Art and Design

Making 3d models of planets using papier-mâché (*Handles tools, objects, construction and malleable materials safely and with increasing control.*) 40-60 months

Making tin robots using cans  
*Using play dough to make aliens (Uses simple tools to effect changes to materials)* 40-60 months

Constructing rockets using wooden blocks

## Physical development

Balance - thinking about how astronauts walk on the moon - balancing

Begin to look at simple team games (year 1) (*Physical Development - moving and handling* 40-60 months - *Negotiates space successfully when playing racing and chasing games with other children, adjusting speed or changing direction to avoid obstacles. Travels with confidence and skill around, under, over and through balancing and climbing equipment*).
