This Week in Reception

This week the children have been thinking about how they celebrate Christmas in their families. We have been comparing how our families differ when celebrating Christmas. The children have drawn some beautiful pictures and some have written sentences about this. I have been carrying out assessments on your children this week to see what level they are working at in their phonics, reading and writing. These assessments will be used to group the children for next term.

Your child will also be allocated a key worker in January. This will either be Mrs Gingell or I. Key workers are used for circle time activities and for observations whilst in class. Key workers are also used to:-

- Help ensure that every child's learning and care is tailored to meet his/her individual needs
- Seek to engage and support parents and/or carers in guiding their child's development at home
- Help families to engage with more specialist support, if appropriate

Although your child will be assigned a key person, Mrs Gingell and I will still observe, assess and monitor all children in class.
