In Science the children have been introduced to the Rock 'n' Roll topic and studied the three rock types and produced posters to illustrate some examples of rocks in action. Next week in Maths the children will continue to fine-tune their time telling and problem solving skills, before moving on to money and applying those skills to solving money problems. In English the class will continue to explore and analyse instructions, and try to make their own instructions even clearer. Science will include an investigation into the durability and permeability of a variety of rocks.
