In English we have been continuing our work on -er and -ed. We noticed that -ed can make different sounds at the end of a word. It can say 't', 'd' or 'id'.

In Maths we looked at the properties of 2D and 3D shapes. We noticed that 3-D shapes had different shaped faces and we made 3D shapes using shape equipment.
