Please note that if you are allowing your child to access such sites, this can become a serious Safeguarding issue, for which you are responsible. Please note the minimum age requirement for the following sites: Facebook 13+, Instagram 13+, Snapchat 13+, Kik 13+, WhatsApp 13+, ooVoo 13+; therefore, NO child at Lea Endowed should be using these sites. These age limits are there for a reason; allowing your child to access these sites is potentially PUTTING YOUR CHILD AT RISK! Please can I encourage you to check daily what your child is accessing and act responsibly. The excuse "Everyone is doing it," does not make something excusable, right, or safe!
