We are Researchers!



In our **English** work we have enjoyed exploring the books 'Bob's Best Ever Friend' and 'Bob and the Moontree Mystery'. We have been creating noun phrases and questions to ask Barry – Bob's new friend.

In **Mathematics** we have been tallying and creating pictograms to record information. We have been asking and answering questions using recorded/collected data.

In **Science** we will have been finding out about carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. We have also researched animals to see which animal group they are part of as well as the food they eat.

Our **Geography** work has focused on daily weather patterns and we have recorded weather over the course of the week.
