This Week

We have been applying our non-fiction knowledge in **English** to plan and produce two informative posters – one advertising a given product, the other informing people about the sugar content in drinks. In **Maths**, we focused on two areas this week, one of them being fractions. We have extended our knowledge and use of adding and subtracting fractions. Our second focus has been on presenting continuous data using graphs. This linked to our **Science** as we created bar graphs to represent the data we collected based on sugar content in drinks. We also created graphs to represent data for certain chicks, as these lovely creatures stayed in our classroom for a day. We used line graphs and bar graphs to track their weight and size. In **RE**, we have read through the Easter story identifying moments when trust and betrayal are being shown. We finally have been able to start to apply our ball skills outside in PE, as we focus on our shooting technique using basketball hoops. In **Computing**, we have started a Coding project in Scratch where we are independently creating a game that applies our knowledge so far.
