This Week

Our Theme for this half term is the 'Amazing Amazon Adventure'. This week we have been conducting assessments. This has two purposes: the first is to provide an opportunity for the children to show how they've progressed; the second is for these assessments to be a learning opportunity for the children, so they can learn how to answer the questions to the best of their ability. In English, we planned and began to write our own version of the Bear Grylls novel 'The Gold of the Gods'. We are seeking to apply all our grammatical features we've been working on. In Maths, we have been applying our skills using the four operations (+, -, x,) in the sphere of statistics. In Science, we have been exploring, in depth, the life cycle of a plant. We have sought to improve our scientific drawing skills including labels. In RE, we looked at why Jesus' authority was challenged. This led us to begin to explore the Jewish celebration of Sabbath, or Shabbat in Hebrew. In Geography, we applied what we have learning so far with mapping skills, labelling a blank map with the continents, oceans, and other essential markers (equator, hemispheres etc.) In Art, we continued to create prints to form our version of 'Tiger in a Tropical Storm'. In PE, we continued to apply our gymnastic skills with rolls (teddy-bear, forward and backward). The Year 5 children also went swimming.

Outstanding Behaviour


We have had a good start to the new year. The children this week that have modelled outstanding behaviour 3 or more times are:
