

This Week

Our **Theme** for this half term is the **'This Little Light of Mine'**. Our focus in **Science** this week was to explore the impact light has on shadows and how white light is made up of 7 colour rays (what we call the rainbow!) In **English**, we have returned to working on the novel 'The Midnight Fox'. We have empathised with Tom, the protagonist, writing in a couple of styles and have grammatically focussed on relative clauses using the relative pronoun 'where'. In **Maths**, our focus has continued with percentages, focussing on finding percentages of amounts. In **History**, we have focussed on why the Saxons only settled in Britain and not in Wales & Scotland; we did this using the digital mapping software Digimaps. In **RE**, we explored the use of light and dark in the Bible. We read Psalm 23 and explored how absence from God is described as darkness. We portrayed it using art. In **Computing**, we continued to think about how to stay safe online. In **French**, we learned how to read, say and recognise colours.

The CURRICULUM award goes to Freya Emptage for a monster defensive display in PE.


