This Week

Our Theme for this half term is the 'Amazing Amazon Adventure'. In English, we have continued writing our non-chronological reports about Brazil. We have researched the country of Brazil, written a brilliant opening paragraph collectively and written, then formatted our own reports. In Maths, our continued topic of place value has focussed on Roman Numerals and negative numbers. We have continued with the fantastic progress we made last week. In Science, we looked at plants and explored the reproductive parts of a flower. We dissected a rose, tulip and lily to understand the different reproductive parts of the flower. In RE, we continued in our quest finding out more about Jesus and him being the Son of God. We looked at how his baptism, the transfiguration and the many healing miracles show Jesus' power and authority. In Geography, we explored the Water Cycle and the journey of a river and began to explore the Amazon river, applying what we learned about the features of a river. In Art, we continued to explore the life of Henri Rousseau (focussing on the painted 'Tiger in a Tropical Storm'. In PE, we began to build some upper body strength that will help us in performing a handstand in gymnastics. The Year 5 children also went swimming.

Outstanding Behaviour


We have had a good start to the new year. We all settled down quickly to the school routine and I hope this will continue. The children this week that have modelled outstanding behaviour 3 or more times are:
