## We are beside the Seaside!



Welcome back after the half term holidays. This half term our topic in class is "At the Seaside".

We will be exploring how the seaside resort of Blackpool has changed over the years from Victorian times to the present day. Our activities will include researching and exploring lighthouses and making puppets for a "Punch and Judy" show.

The children will be set homework projects to complete over the coming weeks and details of these projects are in your child's homework book this week. Copies will also be available to refer to on the school website.

This week our **English** work has linked to the story "Winnie at the Seaside". The children have been retelling stories, using coordination and subordination in their sentence writing and begun learning seaside related vocabulary.

In **Mathematics** we have been exploring reading and drawing times to five minute intervals and solved problems using their knowledge of time intervals.

Our **Science** work will focus on materials and their uses. We will be investigating changes to materials and how their properties can affect how they are used.

Our **RE** topic this half term is Pentecost and the Ascension. This week we have been exploring and discussing times when we say goodbye, and how Jesus said goodbye to his disciples.

**Reading** – Please spend 10 minutes every day reading or sharing a book with your child.

English – 4 week research project. Details in homework books.

**Spellings** – Topic vocabulary

**Mathematics** – x tables (x2, x5 & x10) – please practise to improve fluency of recall.




## Next Week we are Problem Solving!
