This Week

In **English**, we started a new genre of writing - newspaper recounts. We explored the different features that makes it unique. We are applying our historical knowledge of the Great Fire of London to this genre, which immediately gives us more of an advantage. In **Maths**, we are focusing on multiplication and division over this week and next. Our focus this week was lots of mental work; we focused on multiples, factors and prime numbers. In **Science**; we enjoyed being together for a science lesson. We started to explore the materials that objects were made from. We are going to investigate the properties of different materials in coming investigations. In **RE**, we discussed what makes our Christmas celebrations unique for us, and then prepared some questions for investigating how it is celebrated around the world. In **Topic (a combination of History and Geography)**, we explored many different maps of London and through reading these maps, we got a better handle on the Geography of the Great Fire of London. In **PE**, we began a unit on gymnastics and focused on balancing. The Year 5 children also went swimming.
