Can I begin by saying how fantastic it has been seeing so many children at the SATs Booster Sessions. It is hoped that these lessons will provide your child with some of the additional skills required to sit an exam. We have so far been learning about how to tackle algebra on the Maths tests and we have thinking about how the number of marks a question is worth determines what kind of answer is required. This is mainly so children can get through all the tests efficiently without missing out any questions.

Due to Parents' Evening on Thursday, there will only be a SATs Booster session on Wednesday next week.

In class we have been busy writing poetry using figurative language and working on pie charts and conversion graphs. In science we spent an afternoon learning about drugs, both legal and illegal. It was clear that there is a wide range of knowledge within class 5 about drugs and their use. Some children thought that certain illegal drugs were in fact legal. Please invest some time at home talking about this so that your child can make informed and safe choices in the future.
