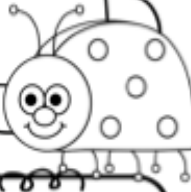

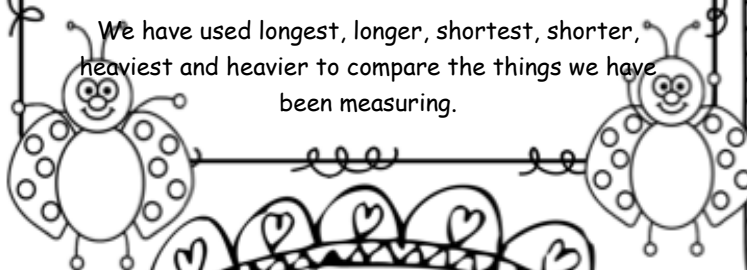
This Week....

Next Week....

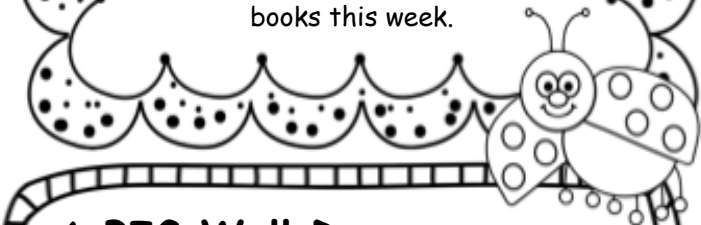
In English we will be learning a robot poem by heart and looking at rhyming words.

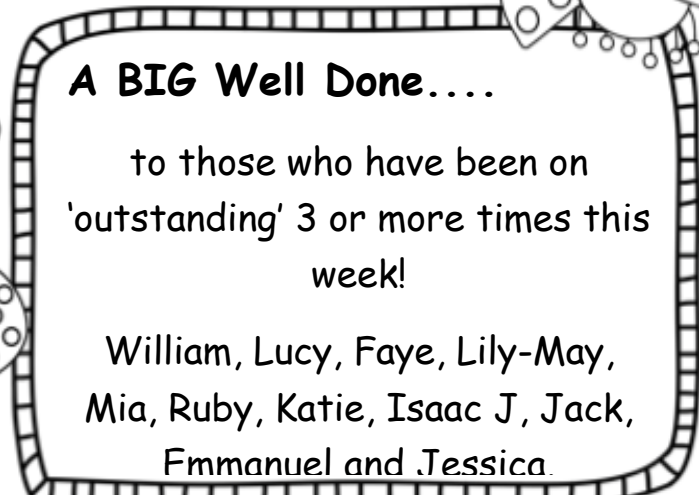
